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# Getting started with Mobile Rad


#### Set up Mobile Rad

Mobile Rad is an app for Android OS devices that mobile technologists can use to manage their orders and dispatches.

#### Install a PDF viewer and Google Maps

A PDF viewer is required to view approved reports and other documents.


1. In Google Play, search for one of the following apps and install it.




2. Also in Google Play, search for and install Google Maps.

#### Install Mobile Rad

- 1. Using Windows File Explorer, copy the Mobile Rad apk to the root directory on your mobile device.
- 2. In your device's file explorer app (such as Samsung > My Files), select the Mobile Rad app.



3. Select an installer app (such as Package Installer).



- 4. When prompted "Do you want to install?", select Install.
- 5. If the Unsafe app blocked screen appears, select More, and then select Install Anyway.




6. In the App installed screen, select Done.

#### Configure permissions

Configure permissions to allow Mobile Rad to use features of your mobile device (including the camera, phone, location, and storage).

1. Press and hold the Mobile RAD icon, and select App info.




2. In the App info screen, open Storage and confirm that MobileRAD appears.

To sign in to Mobile Rad:


1. Select the icon on the home screen.

3. In the pop-up window, type the Exa platform server URL or hostname with /api/ appended to the end (final slash is required), and then select YES.



4. Back on the home screen, type your username, password, and company code, and then select LOGIN.

# Perform an exam

Mobile Rad opens to the NEW ORDER tab, which lists orders dispatched to you.

1. On the NEW ORDER tab, select an order.

2. Optional. To modify patient alerts and add order notes, tap the edit button next to Patient Alerts.



4. Optional. To view and modify job details and add study notes, under Job Study Details, tap the edit button, and then in the Job Study Details screen, tap the edit button of a job.






Tap the edit button... ... to view details and add study notes
